



James Wilson Award for Outstanding Research and Leadership in the Field of Cooperative Education, Internships, and Work-Integrated Learning (WIL)

James W. Wilson was the Asa S. Knowles Professor of Cooperative Education and Director of Northeastern’s Cooperative Education Research Center for many years. In 1987, he co-authored a comprehensive book about cooperative education, *Cooperative Education in a New Era*, as well as numerous other books and articles.

This award recognizes outstanding contributions to the promotion and advocacy of research activity in cooperative education. The award is not given every year. The award is competitively determined and is intended to recognize longstanding contributions to the field both by participating in research activity and providing leadership for others. The winner will be honored at the CEIA annual conference.
