Call for Nominations for CEIA Board of Directors

This year's Nominations and Elections Committee, under the leadership of Immediate Past President, Randy Poole, (Prince George's Community College) is seeking nominations for the 2014-15 Board of Directors. As members of CEIA, one of your rights is to nominate or become one of the leaders of our Association. It is your responsibility to vote for the colleagues of your choice to guide CEIA.

All candidates must be members in good standing prior to a nomination. Nominees should have the consent of their company/institution since Board positions require time out of the office for travel to Board meetings, the Annual Conference and time throughout the year to tend to Board responsibilities. Some costs off attending Board meetings are covered by CEIA, but there will costs that that individuals, their company or institution will be expected to cover. Please contact persons you wish to nominate ahead of time to determine if they are interested, meet the requirements and are willing to serve for at least two years.

Nominations for the following Board positions are being sought:

Executive Vice President/President-Elect – priority will be given to nominees from Region 5, Southwestern US, Region 6, Mountains & Plains US or Region 7, Western US (three year term).

Nominees for Executive Vice President/President-Elect must have significant previous CEIA Board experience at the time of nomination. He/she shall assist the President and shall exercise the powers and duties of the President in the absence of the President. Executive Vice President/President-Elect also coordinates the activities of the CEIA conference committee and prepares the Annual Report.

Vice President Region 1 (Northeast):	OPEN
Vice President Region 3 (Southeast):	Carmen Diaz eligible
Vice President Region 5 (Southwest):	Steve Sellars eligible
Vice President Region 7 (West):	OPEN

Regional Vice Presidents shall ensure the fair and equal representation of their respective constituencies on the Board. All communication and activities sponsored by CEIA on behalf of

the membership constituency within respective regions shall be conducted in collaboration with the Regional Vice Presidents.
