Podcast hosts will conduct a live-for-audience interview with Nancy L. Zimpher (Chancellor Emeritus of The State University of New York, SUNY) and Dan Cayse (retired Vice President of Strategic Initiatives & Entrepreneurial Development at Cincinnati State Technical & Community College).

Dr. Zimpher is co-founder and immediate past chair of StriveTogether, a national network of innovative partnerships that holistically address challenges across the education pipeline. As SUNY chancellor, she served as chair of the National Association of System Heads from 2014–2017, the Board of Governors of the New York Academy of Sciences from 2011–2016, and CEOs for Cities from 2012–2013, and led the national Coalition of Urban Serving Universities from 2005–2011.

During his combined 40-plus years of service, Dan Cayse has made major contributions to the field. As Dean, then later Vice President, at Cincinnati State Technical and Community College, he was responsible for the academic affairs and co-op program for 24 Associate Degree Programs and 14 Certificates for the Business Technologies Division. Under his leadership, the Business Technologies Division developed a nationally recognized academic and cooperative model that led to strategic partnerships with companies such as Walt Disney World, Procter & Gamble and The Kroger Company.
