CEIA Celebrates 60 Years




Have you ever heard of these phases?

These were developed by the Ad Council, a nonprofit organization that produces, distributes, and promotes public service announcements of various sponsors, including nonprofit organizations. In 1985, they helped develop a National Ad Campaign (\$30 million) bringing cooperative education to the forefront to university and college administrators and employers. This public campaign drove strong progress in establishing partnerships across the country.
